The shows are about to start.

Landscape Photography Courses

Lake District, Peak District, Northumberland and Glen Coe

We are running a full programme of courses again this year with 2 new locations.

Landscape photography courses start this month with a 1 day course (Saturday 17th March) in the Peak District (near Hathersage) with just 1 place left.

We had hoped to run a 1 day course in the Lakes as well but it clashed with the new Haddon Hall show so we cancelled it before taking any bookings.

New locations include Northumberland (based in Berwick-upon-Tweed in April) and Glen Coe (based in Ballachulish near Glen Coe in September). Places still available on both. You can book 1, 2 or 3 days.

Unfortunately the Yorkshire Dales course has been cancelled as we have booked a new show at the same time in Hatfield House in May and we didn't have any dates free that we could move it to.

Photo Tips

Seasonal Notes from Derbyshire

Looks like we have seen the last snow of the winter. It's quite mild at the moment with good days in between wet ones. Rivers and waterfalls are in good form so try different shutter speeds to see what effects they produce. Trees don't have any leaves and look great against a blue sky with a few clouds. Look for patterns in the branches and a suitable lead in from the edge of the frame. Try exposing for the sky and take a few silhouettes and then expose for the tree itself. See which you prefer.

The birds are coming back on the moors too, Lapwings are already here and Curlews should be here any day. They

always it more interesting when out photographing on the tops, not that I'm looking to put them in my pictures but you can just enjoy watching and hearing them.
