

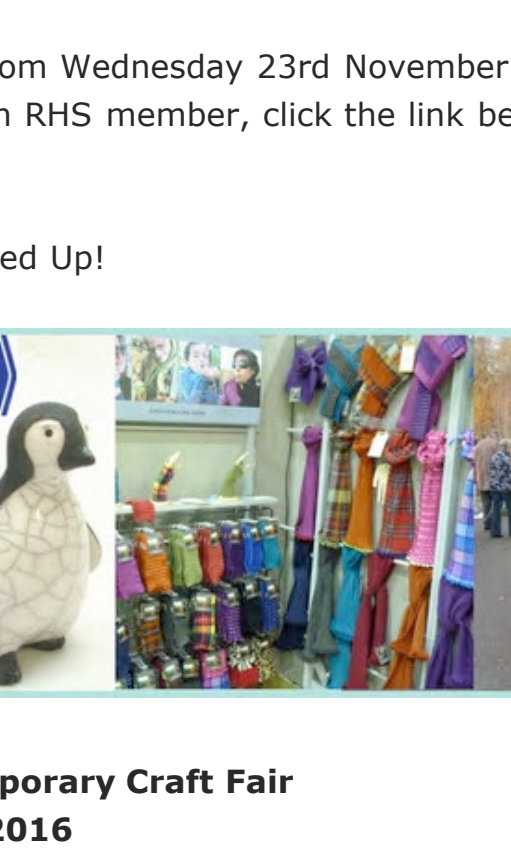

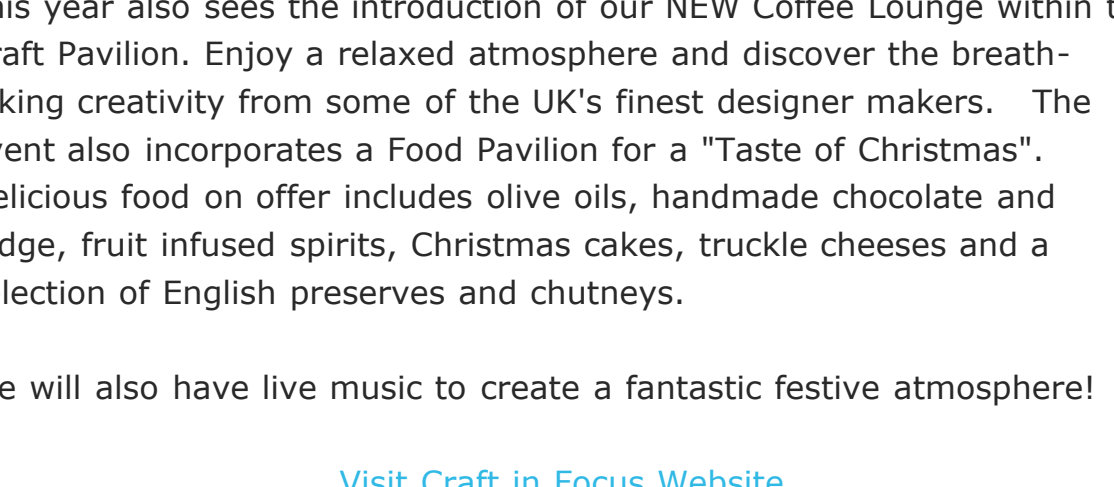
Events 2016

Closest stations are West Byfleet (4 miles) or Woking (7 miles). There are no taxis on standby at West Byfleet.

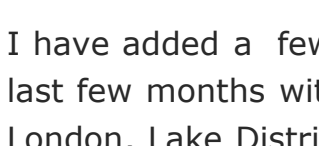
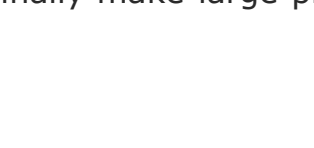
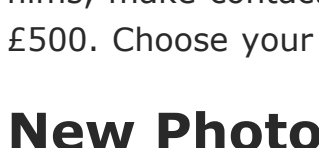

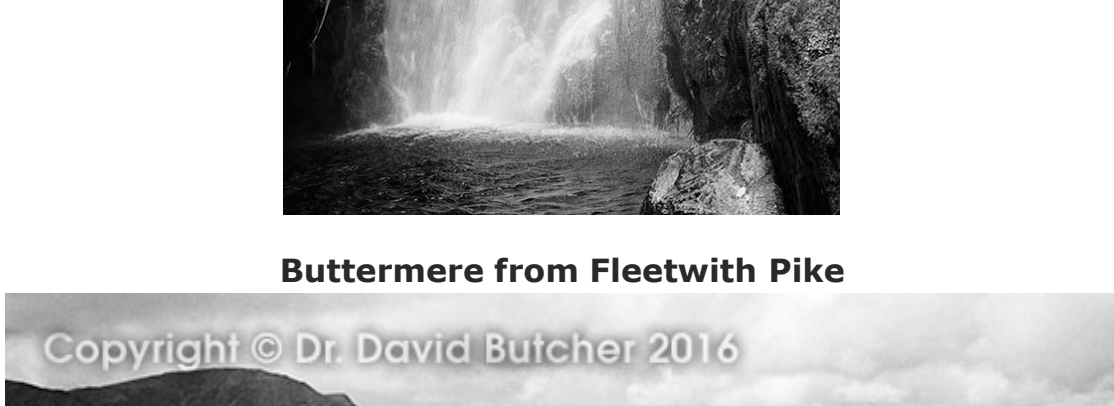
New Photos

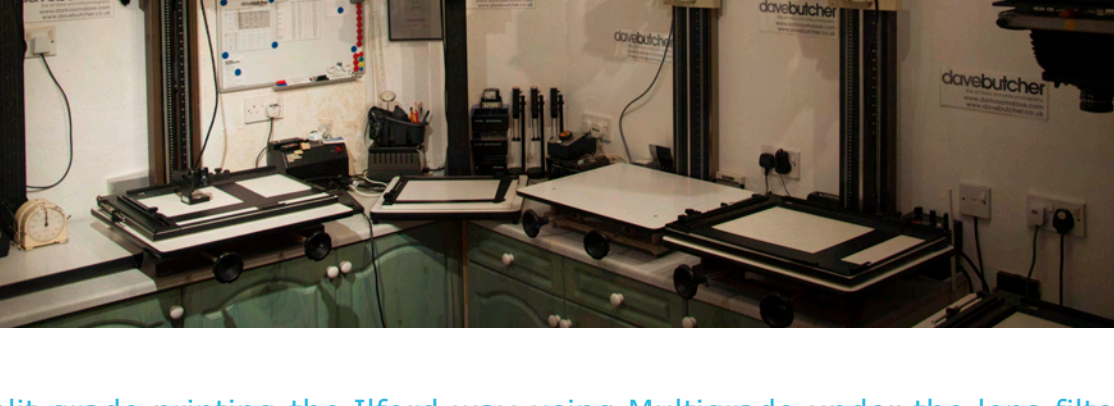

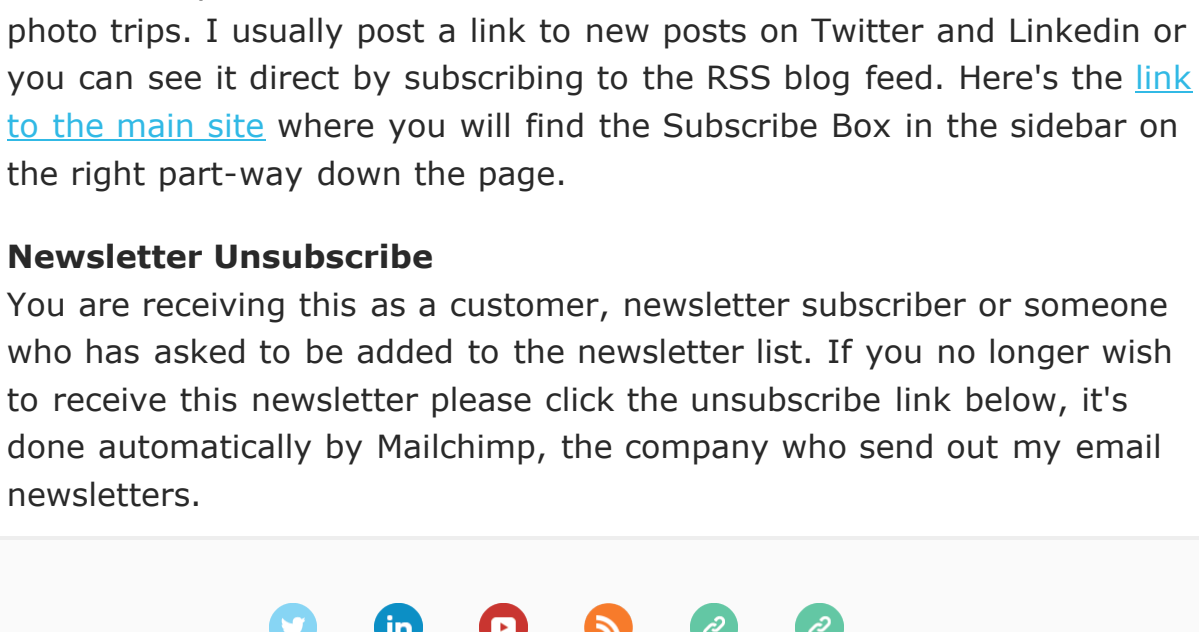

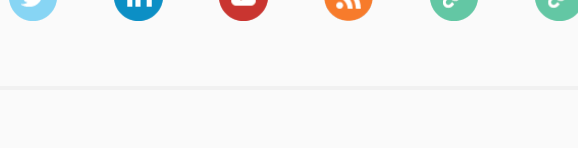
